## 2022 Report on The Bulletin

The Bulletin continues to be published three times per year; Winter, Spring and Fall. We still need volunteers to be part of the publication committee.

The Winter 2022 edition featured an article by Marco Adria, the Moderator of First Baptist Church, Edmonton. With First Edmonton joining the CABF in the fall 2021, we are now a nationwide Association. The fall 2022 edition featured responses to the much anticipated 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary held in early June 2022 at Wolfville Baptist Church. I tried to select contributors either new to the CABF, or in the prime of their careers, as I suspect the CABF will require more leadership from this generation in the future.

Going forward I hope to solicit new faces to contribute articles. The next edition due in the Winter 2023 will focus on the theme of *Pastoral Care as a means of healing and wholeness*.

Our total current circulation is 1158. *The Bulletin* is sent to 188 individual households. We send 933 copies to 41 churches but nearly half of this total is distributed to five churches, Wolfville, Amherst, Port Williams, Falmouth and Pereaux. We send 37 copies to universities, colleges and associations.

I am grateful for the kind comments offered by friends who read *The Bulletin* regularly, and for the graciousness people have shown to me as an editor. I'm also thankful to those who have produced articles when approached, and for David Allen who keeps track of the distribution list.
